## SACRAMENTS

### Baptism:

All arrangements, including confirmation of the date, must be made with the parish office.

Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. Sponsors, if married, must either be married in the Church or with the Church's permission. Parents must attend Baptismal Preparation, which is regularly scheduled throughout the year.

### Marriage:

Arrangements must be made directly with the pastor at least 6 months before the date of the wedding. Marriage preparation is required and couples are asked to speak to the priest first before setting a date. Couples, rather than parents, should contact the priest. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

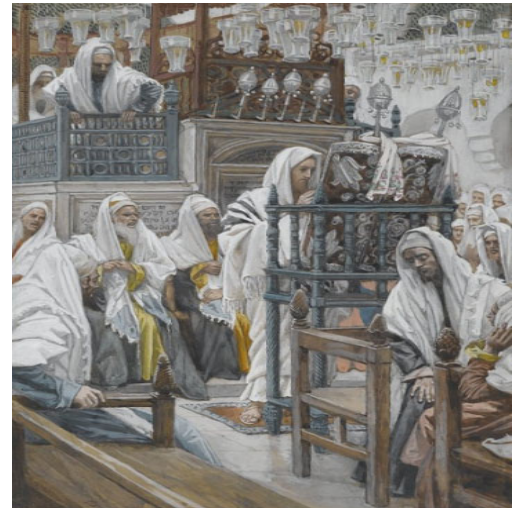
### Gospel

~ Luke 1:1-4, 4:14-21 ~

### Reflection

The telling of this story is unique to the Gospel of Luke, providing us with information that's not given in the other two synoptic accounts. Jesus is preaching in his hometown

where he was known not as the Second Person of the Trinity, but in the fullness of his humanity. Although Jesus' identity wasn't known to those whom he taught, it's quite clear in the Scriptures that he knew who he was and understood his role. Today's reading begins to establish the identity of Christ clearly within the context of what the Church calls salvation history. The messianic proclamation that Jesus begins in this episode from Luke will become broader and deeper as the Gospel advances and will not, in fact, be fully explicated until Luke's Acts of the Apostles. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus himself is the principle of unity between the Old and New Testaments, the key to salvation history.
